Kindergarten Stepping Stones is founded on the philosophy, goals, and essential core elements of Adventist education as outlined in Journey to Excellence, and is based on current research and best practices in teaching young children. *Kindergarten Stepping Stones* presents solid academic concepts while focusing on the developmental level of the child.

Philosophy

Kindergarten is an important time of transition for young children. It is a "stepping stone" or bridge between home, early childhood education, and the primary grades of school. It is a "children's garden" where young ones, uniquely created in God's image, are nurtured, and where professional Christian educators celebrate the intrinsic worth and value of each child, understanding that each brings to the classroom a different set of beliefs, customs, traditions, values, and experiences. There is not a set body of knowledge and skills required for entrance to kindergarten or first grade. Start every child where he or she is and take that child as far as he or she is able to go.



- Bible Story/Music CDs—contain a recording of the Bible stories and songs for each child to take home.







Teacher Resources


- Daily Lesson Guides and Blackline CDs—

Stairway to Reading Components


Stairway to Reading is an individualized and sequential step-by-step phonics program. It bridges the child's ability to hear sounds in words to the ability to recognize the letters representing those sounds. The child is then guided to put those sounds/letters together to make words. Finally, words are combined to tell a story, and through individual phonetic readers, authentic reading practice is provided.





Cross-Curricular Themes

Cross-curricular themes serve as the overriding framework for the program. Theme books provide the basis for skill-building activities throughout the curriculum. Themes range from personal, spiritual, and family-oriented ones to those incorporating cultural, sociological, and environmental issues. Spiritual lessons are drawn from each theme that relate to the children's personal spiritual journeys.

Kindergarten Stepping Stones follows the nine themes found in *Pathways*. *Kindergarten*

Stepping Stones adds an introductory theme, Off We Go, at the beginning of the year as a way to introduce the children to the school setting. Although the same nine themes occur at every grade level, specific theme content changes to reflect the developmental and interest levels of the children. The thematic structure offers consistency across grade levels and a framework for the literature units.
