

## MATH ACTIVITIES

### LARGE-GROUP WORK

Actively involve the children in a variety of math experiences to help them internalize concepts.

#### Large Group: Estimating—How Many Snowballs?


Label each of five resealable sandwich bags A, B, C, D, and E. Place a different number of cotton balls in each bag. Invite the children to examine the bags and estimate the number of “snowballs” in each. Provide each child with a copy of Blackline 1.6 to record his or her estimate. After all estimates are recorded, open one bag at a time and ask the children to count the actual number of snowballs in each. Record the actual number of “snowballs” in the second column of the blackline.

#### Large Group: Graphing—Do You Like the Snow?

Create a two-column graph titled “Do You Like the Snow?” Cut apart snowflakes from Blackline 1.7 for the children to record their responses. Post “yes” responses in column 1 and “no” responses in column 2. Discuss and compare results.
